

Quest Language Studies Covid-19 Vaccine Policy

The health and safety of the Quest's and Toronto communities remain our top priority. Following the recent recommendation made by the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health (OCMOH) , Quest Language Studies is implementing mandatory Covid-19 vaccination requirements to all individuals (staff, students,visitors and volunteers) who are intending to physically attend the Quest campus.

Fully vaccinated

You are considered fully vaccinated 14days after receiving the recommended number of doses of a Health Canada and/or the World Health Organization (WHO) approved vaccines.

Accepted vaccines

Pfizer-BioNTech	2 does
Moderna	2 does
AstraZeneca	2 does
Janssen/Johnson & Johnson	1 does
Sinopharm	2 does
Sinovac	2 does

Proof of Covid-19 vaccination

All individuals coming on campus are required to provide a photograph of a paper vaccination receipt or an electronic receipt.

Unvaccinated international students arriving from outside Canada

Unvaccinated international students must get a first dose of a vaccine within the first week after the mandatory 14 day quarantine period is over and get a second dose as soon as after the minimum required interval period has passed.

Students who received a first dose or a second dose of vaccine can attend the school from a day after their vaccination under the condition that they provide negative covid-19 test results every Monday or the beginning of the week until they are fully vaccinated. (14 days after either having received their approved single-dose vaccine or the second dose of an approved double-dose vaccine.)

Medical Exemptions

Quest will exempt students from the mandatory vaccination policies on medical grounds.

Students must provide Quest with a written documentation signed by a licensed physician or nurse practitioner stating the reason the individual cannot get vaccinated against Covid-19 with the specification of the time duration of the exemption.
